

The Mayor and Council of the Town of Centralhatchee met for a called meeting on Monday, **April 24, 2017**, at 6:00 p.m., at the New City Hall with Mayor Barbie Crockett presiding.

Council present were Eley Loftin, Julia Hand, Pepper Jackson, Barbara Norwood, Walt Wiggins, and Clerk, Linda Rogers.

Visitors present: Mike Crockett, Charles Norwood, Tyson Glore, and Zeke Jervis.

1. Mayor Crockett called the meeting to order and Mike Crockett gave the invocation.
2. The purpose of this called meeting is to allow the Council members to walk through the building to determine if we are ready to make the transition and move into the new facility.
3. Mike Crockett provided an update on several items prior to the walk through, to include the following:
 - Fence along north side property line and around detention pond will be installed later this week.
 - Curbing issues identified on previous tour have been repaired.
 - Bobby Reid will be asked to return for some touch up work in areas identified around the front and rear of the building.
 - As part of a community project, kids from the school will be assisting Chad plant monkey grass on Wednesday afternoon.
 - Sod will be planted in the front island, around the flag pole, and along the embankment adjacent to the steps.
 - Additional grading is necessary, once the ground dries out, on the embankment area before grass can be sowed and lay the sod.
4. The following items identified by Council:
 - Carpet area in front of Chamber desk not smooth.
 - Issues identified on the Chamber desk, Mike will reach out to Joe.
 - Post height restrictions on the rear unloading/loading area.
 - Street address number to be centered above main entry door.
 - Location for placement of mailbox.

Following the walk through of both levels and outside area of the new facility there was a motion and second (B. Norwood/J. Hand) to schedule furniture delivery and proceed with move. The vote was unanimous.

There being no other business to discuss and on motion and second (E. Loftin/B. Norwood) the meeting adjourned. The vote was unanimous.
