

Ephesus City Hall announces changes in Office Operations

Beginning Monday, March 16, 2020, Ephesus City Hall will implement restricted contact with the public in an effort to minimize the risk of spreading the COVID-19 virus. This restricted contact will remain in effect until further notice.

City Hall will remain OPEN but our doors are locked and we are not conducting business in person.

However, we will still be able to meet all the needs of our customer's by way of the Drive Thru window, which is located on the side of the building facing the Elementary School. Water payments can be taken over the telephone, dropped off in the After Hours Deposit on the opposite side of the building from the drive thru window, made on line at www.ephesusga.com on a laptop or regular computer (Mobil App's are not available- which means cell phones or tablets) and of course you can email us with any questions at ephesuscityhall@gmail.com
